Sisters Of The Road, Inc. has collected the stories of 600 people with the experience of homelessness. 515 are suitable for analysis and have been used to create database full of people's thoughts and feelings on a wide range of topics. This data is available to all. The following release outlines all pertinent information regarding use of these data.

1. The data is the copyrighted property of Sisters Of The Road, Inc. (SOR).
2. Any product using the data shall report this copyright.
3. Any product using the data shall acknowledge or thank SOR.
4. Any product using the data shall honor the guiding philosophies of SOR: non-violence and gentle personalism, and shall be non-humiliating to any one.
5. The identity of the narrators shall be protected in all circumstances. If necessary, people's names (theirs and others'), and other identifying comments, must be omitted from any product using the data to protect anonymity of individuals.
6. Any product using the data shall state that while the data belongs to SOR, the viewpoints expressed in the data are not necessarily those of SOR.
7. SOR will be informed of and provided with copies of all products using the data.
8. Users of the data are encouraged to have these products published on SOR's online Working Paper Series.
9. All users of the data must submit a biography, on next page.
